- State learning gain scores are based on end of year data compared to previous year end of year data.
- Goals for current year:
 - ELA 3rd Grade 83%, up 3%
 - Science Grade 5 74%, up 3%

 - The SAC voted to approve the School Improvement Plan.
- Mrs. Riddle advised that the school would likely lose one resource position due to the current enrollment counts.
 - K-3 district allocates resources based on the school average of 18 students per class

 - Gifted classes have higher student count on average
