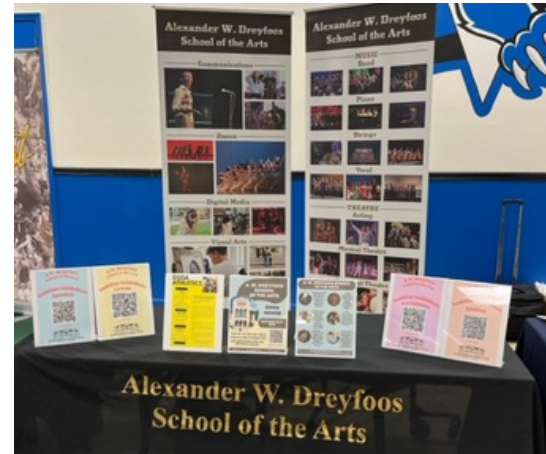

Student and Family Handbook

The purpose of the Student and Family Handbook is to communicate the expectations, policies, and procedures for the school year for all of the students and their families in Palm Beach County Schools. This is the handbook used to guide every school in Palm Beach County and is a valuable resource.

The FY24 Student and Family Handbook is complete and available on the District Website in English, Spanish, Portuguese, and Haitian Creole.

Wellness Update Parent/Guardian Consent

Florida Statute F.S. 1002.20(3)(p) allows a student to possess and self-administer headache medication to relieve headaches while on school property or at a school-sponsored event or activity without a physician's note or prescription. The medication must be regulated by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for over-the-counter use to treat headaches.

Parents/guardians requesting the student to self-administer over-the-counter headache medication must submit a written request to the principal on Form PBSD 2683.

Water Safety and Swimming Certification

Water safety is so important for everyone raising children in South Florida, that's why we are sharing the "Be Water Smart" booklets produced by the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Palm Beach County. 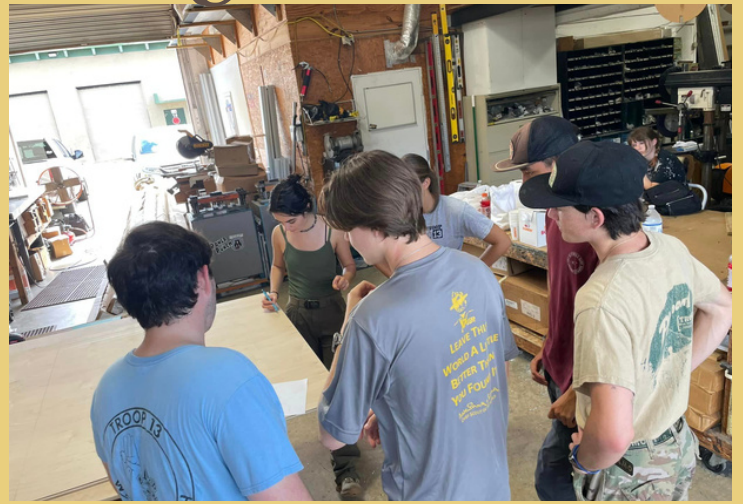
Siena Barefoot has been chosen as a semifinalist for the 2024 Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation!

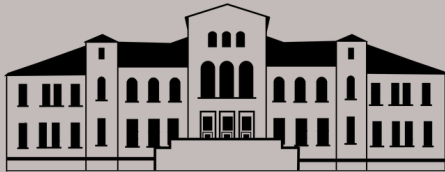
