

# Using SuccessMaker at Home



## Hello Families!

As you consider ways to best support your child, we wanted to let you know that **SuccessMaker** can be a great way to **continue learning at home**.

SuccessMaker is designed to meet specific math goals for your child. The program continuously adapts to ask questions at your student's functional level. We know each learner is unique and have strategically designed our program to help each learner reach their strongest potential.

As you begin using SuccessMaker Math at home, consider the following:

How can my student <b>access</b> SuccessMaker at home?	<i>SuccessMaker is a web-based curriculum. Your student can login through the Palm Beach School District portal.</i>
What <b>devices</b> can my student use?	<i>SuccessMaker is optimized for desktop or laptop computers, and some tablets. You can test your home computer's compatibility using this link: <a href="http://browserinfo.smhost.net">http://browserinfo.smhost.net</a>.</i>
How often should my student <b>use</b> SuccessMaker?	<i>We recommend checking with your child's teacher on recommended frequency! Students can login to SuccessMaker and complete a session at any point in the day.</i>
How <b>long</b> is a SuccessMaker session?	<i>Typical SuccessMaker sessions are 15-20 minutes.</i>
How can I best <b>support</b> my child while using SuccessMaker?	<i>SuccessMaker is an opportunity for <b>independent practice</b>. Finding a quiet time during the day where a student can work is most helpful. Consider having a piece of scratch paper if working on math. Headphones may also be helpful for your child but are not a requirement. Remind your student to "logout" prior to exiting their session. An encouraging environment is most important!</i>
