Annual Title I Meeting

Parent and Family Engagement Trainings

- **Roadrunner Family Night Beginning of Year**: As a result of this training, families will be able to better support their children's learning by understanding the demands of grade level standards in content area courses for the first semester.
- **Roadrunner Family Night Middle of Year**: As a result of this training, families will be able to better support their children's learning by understanding the demands of grade level standards in content area courses for the second semester.
- **Roadrunner Family Night End of Year**: As a result of this training, families will be able to better support their children's learning by understanding the demands of grade level standards and FAST/EOC testing in content area courses.

Coordination and Integration

- **Migrant Education Program:** Migrant Education provides extended learning opportunities in all core subject areas for our migrant students as well as school supplies
- **Drug Abuse Treatment Association:** A counselor from this agency works closely with students and focuses on reducing risk factors generally associated with the progression of substance abuse use and mental health problems. The counselor also does home visits and participates in SBT and Wellness meetings.
- **Communities in Schools of Palm Beach County:** A counselor from the agency monitors student achievement and strengthens student problem solving skills. Duties include individual and group counseling, home visits, assistance for parents and getting involved in their child's education. The counselor also attends SBT and Wellness meetings.

Shared Decision-Making

Families will be invited to SAC, Town Hall, Family Nights, and other meetings throughout the year to receive academic information, reports, and provide input on ways the school, families, and students can share responsibility for student success.

Key Points of Communication

- Parents will be notified of our Title I programs via the Parent Link, SIS Gateway, marquee, and personal invitations/flyers.
- Parents will be notified about Florida Standards, standardized and District assessments, and achievement levels via the Parent Link, SIS Gateway, marquee, and personal invitations/flyers, parent conferences, progress reports, report cards, curriculum night.
- Parents will be invited to attend meetings and participate in evaluating and revising the school's current Parent and Family Engagement Plan and Compact.
- The members of the School Advisory Council will approve and revise the School Improvement Plan. Communication will occur via Parent Link, SIS Gateway, marquee, and flyers.

Accessibility for all Families
