Mandatory Uniform Dress Code Policy

General Information

Research and experience show that the way students dress has a direct influence on how they behave. Since the Meadow Park School Community expects only the BEST behavior from our students, the School Advisory Council reached consensus to initiate a mandatory Uniform Dress Code Policy.

SHIRTS & BLOUSES

- Polo style shirts-any solid color
- Meadow Park school shirt (polo or t-shirt)
- Meadow Park PE Uniform



SHOES

- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Sneakers, loafers, or other closed toe shoes are required.
- No open, unsafe footwear such as flip-flops, sandals, clogs, platform shoes or soles over one-inch.
- No heeys with or without wheels.
- No cros



★ Remember student have P.E./Recess daily

Dress Code Violations

Violations will result in:

- Parent contact
- Student required to change to meet dress code.
- Additional consequences will apply for habitual or major infractions.
- Students with innapropriate shoes will sit out of P.E. or recess.

Pants & Shorts

- Pants and shorts must be solid navy blue, black , gray or khaki.
- Students may wear navy blue or black denim on FRIDAYS or Spirit days (no holes or patches).
- No short-shorts or spandex
- The length of shorts/skorts/ skirts/jumpers must be no more than 2-3 inches above the knee.
- Pants/Shorts must be worn at the natural waistline.



ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

- Hats or Caps
- Tank tops, halter tops, midriiffs
- T-shirts with inappropriate language or pictures
- Clothes with large holes
- Backless or cutoff clothing
- Large, oversized earrings/jewelry

Palm Beach County dress code restrictions continue to apply.

★ Exceptions are made on picture days and some spirit days. The school will notify you of any changes.

CAMISAS & BLUSAS

- Camisas tipo polo – cualquier color solido
- Camisetas de Espíritu Escolar de Meadow Park (polo o camiseta)
- Uniforme de Educación Física de Meadow Park



ZAPATOS

- Deben usar zapatos en todo momento.
- Se requieren tenis, zapatillas u otros zapatos cerrados.
- No zapatos abiertos e inseguros como chancletas, sandalias, zuecos, plataformas o suelas de más de una pulgada.
- No zapatos con rueditas.
- No crocs

Violaciones del Código de Vestir

Las violaciones resultarán en:

- Comunicación a los padres
- El estudiante deberá cambiarse para satisfacer el código de vestir.
- Se aplicarán consecuencias adicionales por infracciones habituales o mayores.
- Los estudiantes con zapatos inadecuados se sentarán fuera de P.E. o recreo.

Pantalones & Shorts

- Los pantalones y shorts deben ser de color sólido azul oscuro, negro, gris o caqui. Los alumnos pueden usar mezclilla (jeans) azul oscuro o negro los VIERNES o los días de espíritu escolar (sin agujeros ni parches.
- No shorts cortos o licras
- El largo de los shorts/faldas/jumpers no debe estar más de 2-3 pulgadas arriba de la rodilla.
- Los pantalones deben usarse en la cintura natural.



ARTICULOS NO PERMITIDOS

- Sombreros /Gorras
- Camisetas sin mangas, blusas sin espalda o cortas
- Camisetas con lenguaje inapropiado o con dibujos
- Ropa con agujeros grandes
- Ropa sin espalda o con cortes
- Aretes grandes de tamaño/joyas

Student ID's and Replacement Procedures

All students will be given a new student ID and lanyard on the first day of school. One ID will remain on your child's backpack and one will remain at school!

Since the School District incurs costs related to providing ID badges to students, a student's first replacement ID badge within the school year will be free of charge to the student. In the event that a student needs a replacement ID badge beyond the first replacement ID badge a fee may be imposed to cover the replacement costs directly related to the replacement ID badge.

If a student requires a replacement badge in excess of five times during the school year, the Principal or Assistant Principal is authorized to follow the established processes for the determination of consequences in compliance with the Student Code of Conduct Policies – Level 1 (5.1812 and 5.1813).

Students who have lost their ID more than one time are now being charged \$5.00. The \$5.00 replacement cost for a replacement badge will include a basic lanyard.

Help Keep Our School Safe!

It is important to remind students of the multiple ways to report bullying on campus and address what to do if they are experiencing any antisemitic incidents at school. The District has several ways a student can report bullying, and it goes directly to the principal of each school:

- The Bullying Hotline 561-434-8200- they can report by calling it in, and a taped recording is sent directly to the school principal.
- Go to ReportBully.PalmBeachSchools.org, which opens a form and sends it directly to the principal.
- Scan a QR Code from posters found on campus to get to the same reporting form.
- A reporting form is also available from the Student Portal at sign-on.

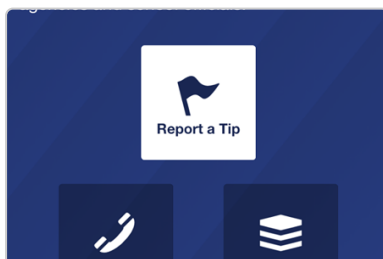
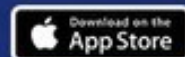
