

Dear Parent or Guardian,

To earn graduation credit and for future success in school and life, your child will have to succeed in his/her math courses. Some courses, like Algebra 1, have high-stakes testing, which means your student has to pass the End-of-Course exam for that course in order to graduate. What is this statewide assessment?

- For your child to receive Algebra I credit and graduate from high school, she/he must pass this test at the end of the semester. For your child to receive Algebra 2 and Geometry graduation credit, she/he must succeed on those respective exams at the end of the semester.

What is Math Nation?

- Math Nation meets your child on his/her own time in a familiar, comfortable pressure free environment. Math Nation is available on online, on iPhones, Android phones, and iPads.
- Highly interactive and fun videos help your child review the material, they learn in the classroom, after school or on the weekends.
- Study guide packets come with every video. Your child can print out study guides and use them to follow along with the videos.
- The "Test Yourself!" practice tool after each section allows your student to check if s/he understood the material. The "Test Yourself!" section will also help your child get comfortable with computer-based testing.
