1. Meeting called to order and Pledge of Allegiance by Jay Matousek, Chairperson at 6:04 p.m.
2. Introductions were completed by all present.
3. Approval of Oct 3, 2023 Minutes - A motion to approve the Oct 3, 2023 minutes was made by Tracy Gulick. Seconded by Mary Murillo. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Treasurer's Report: Lauren Strayer reviewed the provided report. Available funding is \$29,280.31
5. Student Activities Report: Lauren Strayer updated and informed the group about the events scheduled. SGA is running a Food for Families drive, and questions about Spirit Week were answered. There are no outstanding funding requests
