1. **Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance:** The meeting called to order and Pledge of Allegiance by Jay Matousek, Chairperson, at 6:11 p.m.
2. **Introductions:** All present completed introductions, reviewed minutes
3. **Approval of Minutes:** Tracy Gulick motioned to approve the minutes for September 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, seconded by Ms. Rute. The minutes were approved by all in attendance.
4. **Funding Requests and Approval Vote:**
  - a. Nothing new
5. **Treasurer's Report:** \$32,631.60 available funds (Jess Baxter, treasurer)
6. **Student Activities Report:**
  - a. Jess Baxter: Art Fair Fundraiser has been moved to November 17<sup>th</sup> from 9-3pm in the school courtyard. Students will be able to sell their artwork to the public. (i.e. drawings, paintings, beading, pottery, etc.) It will be \$100 per table for up to 4 students.
  - b. Homecoming week is October 21<sup>st</sup> -26<sup>th</sup> (pep rally the 21<sup>st</sup> , game on the 25<sup>th</sup> and dance on the 26<sup>th</sup>)
  - c. Homecoming game will also be senior night.
  - d. Homecoming Dance:
    - i. Ticket sales begin Monday October 7<sup>th</sup>- 9<sup>th</sup> for Seniors, 10<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> for under class and opens to guests that don't attend JHS on the 16<sup>th</sup>
    - ii. Parent volunteers needed for the homecoming dance
    - iii. Question: Is there a reason the king and queen have to be a couple?  
It appears there has been a discussion amongst parents on a social media page implying that you must be a couple to be nominated. Coach D doesn't think it has to be, but that's how it usually happens.
  - e. Carnival: Coach D is looking into a table for chicken dinner tickets
7. **Principal's Report:**
  - a. Dr I. was not in attendance. Via message she stated everything is good.

- c. Follow up to Library Renovation: Café – The school requested that the café be placed where the windows are instead of locating it in the hygiene nook. They thought it would be best where they can convert the windows to sliding windows and the area already has a water line and refrigerator.

**8. Good of the Order/Comments:**

- a. Elisabeth Trotta, Librarian with the Public Library:
  - i. There is a new volunteer program which will make it easier for students to print their hours. The program started today.
- b. Questions asked: Where does the \$32,631.60 funds come from on the budget? Funds are provided by the district and state based on performance and enrollment. Unspent and forfeited classroom supply program represents the \$300 each teacher receives for class supplies. If the entire amount is not used the balance is forfeited to the communal budget.
- c. Chicken Dinner is going to start soon. Funds go towards project graduation. Last years pricing was \$15, may need to increase pricing.
- d. One Tribe Newsletter: Question- Is there any way to follow the events without using social media. Website is not helpful. District has taken back the website and can only be updated by the district. 60% of the requests sent to the district, to update website material, are ignored. Maybe a text with a link to the newsletter would be helpful to parents. Is it possible to add SGA events on the website?
