Eligible high school students may be able to earn college and high school credit simultaneously. The best part of this opportunity – while the credit is doubled, it is also free!!!



Dual Enrollment & Early Admission What's the difference?

- **Dual enrollment** is a program where eligible high school students attend college part-time to earn college credits while still fulfilling high school graduation requirements.
- This is part-time enrollment in which a student can take up to 8 credits each term (Fall, Spring and Summer).
- Note: Florida Atlantic University Summer Term students can take up to 4 credits.
- **Early admission** is a program where eligible high school seniors attend college full-time to earn college credits while still fulfilling high school graduation requirements.
- This is full-time enrollment in which a student takes 12 - 18 credits each term (Fall, Spring of senior year)

IS DUAL ENROLLMENT OR EARLY ADMISSION RIGHT FOR EVERYONE?

This is an excellent opportunity for your child to take challenging, rigorous courses. Please keep in mind that these college courses might require more work than what is required in their high school course load.

GREAT DEALS!

- \$\$\$ - You are saving money.
- Earning college and high school credit at the same time.
- College experience while still in high school.
- Dual enrollment courses are weighted the same as AP and AICE courses.
- Voucher for textbooks.

IMPORTANT FACTORS TO CONSIDER

- Your child is beginning their college transcript.
- The grades are also on their high school transcript.
- If a low grade is earned, it may impact future financial aid, college admission and major requirements.
- There is a Drop/Add period if your child no longer wants to take the course.
- A D, F or W (Withdrawing from a course) will withdraw you from the dual enrollment program.
- Course load.
- Classes are after our school day ends.
- Clubs, sports, personal responsibilities.
- Florida Virtual School/Palm Beach Virtual School classes are not the same as taking a dual enrollment course online.
- Personal time
- School calendar v. College calendar

SPRING 2024 CALENDAR COMPARISON (A few dates to reference)

Palm Beach County School District

- Classes begin on Tuesday, January 9th.
- Spring Break is March 18th – 22nd.
- Last day of school is May 30th.

Palm Beach State College

- Classes begin on Monday, January 8th.
- Spring Break is March 4th – 10th.
- Last day of classes/final exams is May 1st.

- **In-person.**
(Campuses are located in Lake Worth, Boca Raton, Palm Beach Gardens, Loxahatchee & Belle Glade)
- Hybrid – Part in person and part online.
- Live online – Specific times via video conference.
- Online – Fully online with specific deadlines.

9th Gr. Dual Enrollment Requirements

- ✓ Unweighted Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- ✓ 4 High School Credits (Must have 1 English credit and 1 Math credit)
- ✓ College-ready Test Scores in Reading, Writing & Math
- ✓ Parent permission.
- ✓ Letter from the principal or designee.
- ✓ Part-time enrollment. A student can take up to 8 credits per term (Fall, Spring or Summer)

10th – 12th Gr. Requirements

- ✓ Unweighted Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- ✓ *College-ready test scores in Reading, Writing & Math
- ✓ Part-time enrollment. A student can take up to 8 credits per term (Fall, Spring or Summer)

12th Gr. Early Admission Requirements

- ✓ Seniors only!
- ✓ Must have an unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
- ✓ College-ready test scores in all three areas - Reading, Writing/English & Math.
- ✓ Letter from the principal. Your child will meet with their School Counselor to receive the letter.
- ✓ Full-time enrollment. Your child must take 12 - 18 credits per term (Fall, Spring)

EXTRA DEALS!!!

- If your 10th – 12th grade child has a 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA and at least one college-ready score, they can take up to 12 credits as a dual enrollment student.
- Can only take one class at a time.
- Must reapply each term.
- If your 12th grader has a 2.75 GPA and at least one college-ready score, they can take the **Introduction to the College Experience** course.
- This opportunity is offered to seniors for the **Spring 2024 Term only!**

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

2 + 2 Scholarship (For high school dual enrollment students)

Award: 2 years of tuition and books

- **Enrollment Requirement:** Min. 12 credits (Fall/Spring), Min. 6 credits (Summer)
- **Funds available:** Fall, Spring, and Summer
- **Funds cover:** In-state tuition and books
- **Criteria:**
 - Graduating high school seniors with a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA.
 - Renewal Cumulative GPA: 3.0
 - Must enroll for classes during the fall term following high school graduation.
 - Must have completed Dual Enrollment courses.
 - Completed an appropriate FAFSA annually

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Finish4Free Scholarship

Award: Full tuition and registration fees for selected students who have earned 30 or more college credits to complete their Associate degree.

- **Enrollment Requirement:** Min. 12 credits
- **Funds available:** Fall and Spring
- **Funds cover:** In-state tuition, registration fees
- **Criteria:**
 - Graduating high school seniors with a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA.
 - Renewal Cumulative GPA: 3.0
 - Must enroll for classes during the fall term following high school graduation.
 - Must have 30 College credits by the time of graduation (Dual Enrollment, AP, AICE or CLEP)
 - Able to renew if continue with PBSC Bachelor's program

FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY

6TH – 12TH Gr. Dual Enrollment Requirements

- Your child must be enrolled in grades 6-12 in either a Palm Beach or Broward County public high school, home education program, or approved private school.
- Receive approval from your high school (via the signed Permission Form)
- Have at least a 3.0 unweighted cumulative high school GPA
- Have completed at least 4 high school credits, with 1 credit in English and 1 in math
- Take the ACT, SAT, Accuplacer, or PERT and achieve **all of the minimum scores on any one test**. Scores from different tests cannot be mixed and matched.

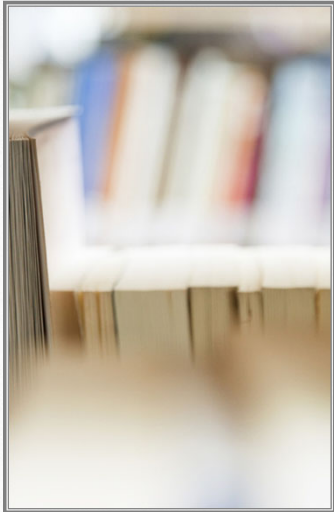
