Earning the AICE International Diploma

- To earn the **AICE Diploma**, candidates must earn a minimum of **7 credits**, which are earned by passing the AICE exams. Students earn 1 credit if they pass as AS level exam, 2 credits if they pass an A level exam.
 - One exam from Groups 1, 2, and 3
 - AS Global Perspectives
 - Three additional Cambridge courses of their choosing from any Group
 - Group 4 credits are **NOT** required for the AICE Diploma, but may be school prerequisites. A maximum of 2 credits from this category can be counted towards the AICE Diploma unless the candidate passes AL Thinking Skills and AL Global Perspectives, then they may use those three.
- All **SEVEN** courses must be completed within **three school years** (a 25 month period).
- AS Level Psychology can be used to meet the requirements for Group 1 or Group 3, but not both.
- Students may apply for their AICE Diploma in 11th or 12th grade, depending on when they start courses or if they need to retake exams they have not passed. We offer AICE General Paper to freshmen, and may not have to use this course towards the Diploma.
- **There are NO MAKE-UP dates for any Cambridge AICE exams.**
- Seminole Ridge High School pays for each exam of a class in which students are enrolled and their first attempt at the AICE Diploma.
 - A student who does not pass an exam may pay for a retake in the **NEXT** testing session. Cost for retakes: \$125 for AS level, \$195 for A level and \$210 for Global.
 - A student who does not fulfill the AICE Diploma requirements in their first attempt may pay for \$143 in the **NEXT** testing session, as long as they sit for an exam that session as well.
- Students may opt out of an exam, but by not sitting for the exam their HPA credit will be dropped to Honors for the course. They will be removed from the class at the start of the next semester, if not immediately.
