Free Driver's Education Opportunity The school district is partnering with the county to offer current high school students free participation. Enrolled students must first complete the A Treasure Coast online driver education program, and then each student will receive free behind-the-wheel driving instruction.

- Students must reside in Palm Beach County (proof required).
- Students must be enrolled in a public, charter, home school, virtual, or high school program.
- Students MUST already have a learner's permit to enroll for this free opportunity.

Registering does NOT guarantee a spot; availability is based on available funding and is first-come, first-served. Students' names will be verified for enrollment with the Palm Beach County School District, and only after enrollment has been verified by the School District can the program begin.
