2ND SEMESTER EXAM INFO

- Exam Week is Tuesday, May 27th through Friday, May 30th:
 - o Tuesday will be a full school day.
 - o Wednesday Friday will be early release.
- ONLY Seniors may be Exempt from a 2nd semester exam.
- Per State statute, students who have been absent for more than the state-permitted 10% of the class (excused AND unexcused), MUST pass the exam to earn credit for the class.
- No early exams will be given. Students who are absent for an exam must make arrangements to make them up after Summer Break.
- Students Give it your BEST! In most cases, these Semester Exams count as 20% of the final semester grade in your classes.

Important SAT, ACT, & CLT Information:

- These tests are used for:
 - o College admission
 - Some scholarship eligibility
 - To meet the required State Reading / Math assessment concordant scores.
- These tests are optional (not a graduation requirement), therefore students must register and pay for them on their own.
 - Test Fee Waivers are available to students who qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch.
 - If you qualify, email the F/R Lunch confirmation you received to your school counselor before you register for the SAT or ACT to obtain a Test Fee Waiver.

• Struggling in a class?

- Attend class regularly and on time.

- Attend tutoring sessions.
- Schedule a Parent-Teacher Conference.

Absences and Course Credit:

- In Block Classes: If you have 5 or more absences (excused or unexcused) you must pass the semester exam to earn credit.
- In 5th Period Class: If you have 10 or more absences (excused or unexcused) you must pass the semester exam to earn credit.
- In EOC Classes: If you have 10 or more absences (excused or unexcused) for you must pass the 4th quarter to earn credit.
- Student-Athletes: Register for NCAA eligibility: <u>NCAA Eligibility Center Registration</u>
- Meet with a PBSC advisor at Dwyer: Receive guidance for Dual Enrollment, career paths application, etc: <u>Book Appointment Here</u>
