STUDENT CHROMEBOOK/LAPTOP, TEXTBOOKS, & MEDIA CENTER BOOKS RETURN:

ATHLETICS INFORMATION:

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY PAPERWORK FOR SUMMER WORKOUTS & 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR:

- Before a student can participate in summer workouts, students **MUST** meet the following requirements:

- 1) Show as enrolled at Dwyer High School for the 2024-2025 school year on SIS.
- 2) Submit all required Athletic Eligibility documents for Summer & the 24-25 school year on [Aktivate.com](#).

Note: all documents must be dated **AFTER June 1, 2024**, with the exception of the 'Athletic Physical Form' (FHSAA EL2) which is good for 365 days.

- If you previously submitted an Athletic Physical on [Aktivate.com](#) that has not expired, it should automatically rollover to the 2024-2025 registration when you start a new registration with the **SAME ACCOUNT** PREVIOUSLY USED.

- 3) Receive a cleared/completed status on your all of the required [Aktivate.com](#) documents/sections.

- [Aktivate.com](#) will open for Summer & 2024-2025 Athletic Eligibility registrations on June 1, 2024.

SCHOOL REMINDERS:

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT PARKING, ATHLETICS, AND ALL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

- To ensure all students are working towards and maintaining the requirements for graduation and beyond, any student wishing participate in school events (such as Homecoming and Prom), athletics, extracurricular activities, athletics, and other school privileges (such as Student Parking) must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1) 2.0 cumulative, unweighted GPA
- 2) Community Service Hours (must be visible on SIS):
 - 10th grade: 5 hours
 - 11th grade: 10 hours
 - 12th grade: 15 hours
- 3) Be cleared of any school financial obligations

- **Be sure to get these requirements met before next school year so you are eligible for a Parking Permit, try-out for sports, attend Homecoming, Prom, and more!**
