## **Earning the AICE International Diploma**

- To earn the **AICE Diploma**, candidates must pass a minimum of 7 AICE exams. Students are expected to take the year-long Cambridge course before sitting for the exam.
- Students must take at least one exam from each of the required groups 1-3. In addition, students must take
  - AS Global Perspectives and Research
  - Three additional Cambridge courses of their choosing from any group. While group 4 credits are **NOT** required for the AICE Diploma, but may be school prerequisites. A maximum of 2 credits from this category can be counted towards the AICE Diploma.
- All SEVEN courses must be completed within three school years (a 25 month period).
- Students may count their freshman, sophomore, and junior exams OR their sophomore, junior and senior exams depending on when they start courses or if they need to retake exams they have not passed.
- A Level courses must be taken the next school year after the completion of an AS Level course.

## **Examination Policies**

- Students are expected to take the exam for each Cambridge (AICE) course in which they are enrolled.
- Cambridge exam are administered in two series: The "June" series (late April to mid June) and "November" series (late September to mid November)
- Cambridge AS exams are graded on a scale of a-e and A Level exams AA-E. A mark of "Ungraded" indicated that a student did not earn enough
  points to receive a passing grade. A "No Result" indicates that a student did not complete one or more components of the exam.
- There are NO MAKE-UP dates for any Cambridge AICE exams.
- SRCHSI pays for each exam of a class in which students are enrolled and their first attempt at the AICE Diploma.
  - A student who does not pass an exam may pay for a retake in the NEXT testing series. Cost for retakes: \$130 for AS level, \$200 for A level and \$215 for Global.
  - A student who does not fulfill the AICE Diploma requirements in their first attempt may pay for \$145 in the NEXT testing session, as long
    as they sit for an exam that session as well.
  - Students who fail to sit for an exam, for any reason, will have their HPA credit dropped to Honors for the course and be responsible for the
    exam fee. Students who drop an AICE course after February 15 will be responsible for the exam fee.
