**SUBJECT: RELEASE OF FY23 PRELIMINARY SCHOOL AND DISTRICT GRADES**

On December 11, 2023, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the FY23 informational baseline School and District Grades. The District received an informational baseline rating of “B” for FY23.

During the FY23 school year, the FDOE transitioned from the Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) to the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST). Therefore, beginning with FY23, the FAST provides the foundation for school grades, which are based on a system adopted by the State Board of Education (SBOE). The school grading system is based on the percentage of total points earned on several components including achievement, learning gains for all students and for the lowest 25% students, high school graduation rates, as well as acceleration success in middle and high school. As FY23 was the first year of FAST administration, the school grade computation excludes the learning gains components and FY23 school grades are being calculated as informational baseline grades only. The current school grades model has been in place since FY16; however, school grades were not released fully in either FY20 or FY21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, the present summary only includes FY18, FY19, FY22, and FY23 for comparison. Schools and districts are rated “A” through “F” based on a percentage of points earned.<sup>2,3</sup>

A review of the FY23 preliminary School and District grades reveals the following:

### District Grades

- Palm Beach was among six of the Seven Largest Florida Districts to earn a “B” grade with an increase in percent of points earned from 63% to 66%.
- When compared with all 67 Florida school districts on total points earned, SDPBC was ranked 19th and one of 36 districts to receive a “B” grade.

<sup>2</sup> The Grading Scale for FY23 varies by school level. **Elementary Schools:** A=62% or greater; B=50% to 61%; C=33% to 49%; D=22% to 32%; and F=21% or less. **Middle Schools:** A=68% or greater; B=58% to 67%; C=40% to 57%; D=31% to 39%; and F=30% or less. **High Schools:** A=70% greater; B=60% to 69%; C=40% to 59%; D=23% to 39%; and F=22% or less. **Combination Schools:** A=67% or greater; B=56% to 66%; C=35% to 55%; D=23% to 34%; and F=22% or less.

<sup>3</sup> This year, the District had 7 schools (2 District-operated) that received an “I” in lieu of a school grade. The “I” grades will be examined further with additional information from FLDOE, but in the interim are excluded from these analyses.

### School Grades

- For FY23, the results for District Traditional<sup>4</sup> schools showed that:
  - 60% of high schools were rated “A” or “B,” a decrease of 25 percentage points from FY22.
  - 54% of middle schools were rated “A” or “B,” no change from FY22.
  - 53% of elementary schools were rated “A” or “B,” a decrease of 5 percentage points from FY22.
  - The District had the highest percentage of “A” rated middle schools among the Seven Largest Florida Districts and the State.
  - The District had the second highest percentage of “A” rated high schools, following Miami-Dade, among the Seven Largest Florida Districts and the State.
  - The District was tied with Pinellas for the highest percentage of “A” rated combination schools.

Tables 1a-1e contain the numbers and percentages of School Grades for Florida and District-operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools. Tables 2a-2e contain the percentages of letter grades for District-operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools in the Seven Largest Florida Districts.<sup>5</sup> Table 3 contains District grades for the Seven Largest Florida Districts. Table 4 contains school grade components for each Palm Beach County School.
