ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR

- 1. Selection procedures for membership (aligned to Florida State Statutes)
- 2. Management of meeting operations
- 3. <u>Requiring a quorum</u> to be present before a vote may be taken by the school advisory council. A majority of membership of the council constitutes a quorum (50% plus 1 of the voting members)
- 4. Requiring at least 3 days' <u>advance notice in writing</u> to all members of the school advisory council of any matter that is scheduled to come before the council for a vote. (Sunshine Law and the School District legal department recommend seven (7) days notification)
- 5. **Scheduling meetings** when parents, students, teachers, business persons, and members of the community can attend
- 6. <u>Replacing any member</u> who has two unexcused consecutive absences from a school advisory council meeting that is noticed according to the procedures in the bylaws
- 7. **Recording minutes** of meetings
- 8. Determining <u>processes to develop and approve requests</u> for school recognition funds and school improvement funds



VIDEOCONFERENCING AND BYLAWS

"Voting members need to be physically present at SAC meetings, unless there is an extraordinary circumstance that disables them from attending, such as hospitalization."

"The attorney general issued an Advisory Legal Opinion (AGO 2003-41) that states: where a rule or statute contemplates that a meeting will be held in a public place with the members physically present, the participation of an absent member in the meeting by telephone conference should be permitted only in extraordinary circumstances and when a quorum of the board members is already physically present at the meeting."

Key Points from Attorney General's Opinion:

- Ensure a quorum is present for remaining members
- Established procedures for video conferencing in bylaws
- Defined extra ordinary circumstances in bylaws



ANNUAL REVIEW

- The schools are required to <u>annually</u> review, approve, and maintain copies of all SAC bylaws. You do not change the date of your bylaws if there is not a revision.
- Your revised SAC bylaws with the new date are posted to the District's School Improvement website for <u>public access</u>.
- Approval of the updated bylaws must be documented in your SAC minutes.

As per Open Government or Sunshine Law, SAC minutes of meetings are permanently kept on file. School Board Policy 2.09
