Middle School Gifted Status 2021-2022

Gifted Placement for Reassigned Student:

The process for a student who is presently on reassignment from his/her home school or is reassigned due to a Choice or Magnet Program and then is assessed with a need for Gifted Services is as follows:

- 1) If the student is not in a Choice Program, the student will return back to the home school, if it has a Gifted Program. If the home school does not have a Gifted Program, the student will be transferred to the school with a gifted program that is geographically closest to the student's address.
- 2) If the student is in a Choice Program and that school has a Gifted Program, the student will be served in both the Choice Program and the Gifted Program at that school. If the school of the Choice Program does not have a Gifted Program, the student will have to choose to either stay in the Choice Program or follow the procedure stated above (#1) for the Gifted Program.
