#### Purpose of the ESE Advisory Council

The purpose of the Council was reviewed. The purpose is to advise the ESE Director and Superintendent about ESE issues. The Chair asked for input from members for issues to be discussed. Suggestions:

- Master Board Scheduling
- Interventions available for each type of disability
- How MSD law affects students with disabilities
- Baker Act
- Under-representation of minorities in autism
- Feeder patterns continuum of services being available in Feeder patterns
- Teacher training especially for students with multiple disabilities.
- Stigma associated with being a student with SLD. Students are not always receptive to receiving support.
- Lack of progress in inclusion of student with significant disabilities.
- Catching up SWD from regression during the pandemic

### <u>Presentation: HB 173 Changes to the Development and implementation of an IEP for</u> <u>transition Services (Kerry Rawn)</u>

- The year for transition planning and services has been lowered two years to age 12 for planning and age 14 for services.
- Provision of Information Document is to be given annually. It has links to many agencies and information.
- Deferment of the diploma is discussed at age 14 or when entering High School.

# Topic: Individual Education Plan - Form 0659 - Janice Coe

- The new IEP was piloted in January 2020 and rolled out to all schools in August 2020.
- The previous IEP was not a system it was a form. The new IEP can be worked on by many people simultaneously.
- Compliance is assured by requiring answers to certain questions.

### Sub-Committee: Paraprofessional allocation update – Sue Davis-Killian

- The Paraprofessional allocation subcommittee submitted a recommendation that the district adopt a formal procedure on how to allocate paras, including how to create fading plans.
- Kevin said that they have started a process based on the student profile that looks at all the adult support already available in the environment.
