2024 Scholarship Instructions

For the 16th consecutive year, the National Council of Jewish Women, SE Atlantic Section, seeks to identify young women in Broward and Palm Beach Counties who possess the qualities to become a Jewish leader of tomorrow.

NCJW has been at the forefront of social change for over 130 years. NCJW courageously takes a progressive stance on issues such as child welfare, women's rights, and reproductive freedom. NCJW is the voice of and the place where women from across society come together to make the world and their communities a better place.

Several winners will be awarded \$1,000 each to be used for tuition or related expenses for higher education (including college, vocational or trade school), travel for Jewish leadership training, or travel to an NCJW national event.

Qualified applicants must be Jewish women, residents of Broward County or Palm Beach County, and enrolled in 12<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2023/2024 school year.

Applicants are invited to submit an essay expressing why they believe they have the potential to become a Jewish leader of tomorrow.

Criteria to be considered include whether the applicant is involved in leadership, advocacy or community service activities, and/or whether she has overcome an obstacle that shows her leadership potential.

The essay must be typed in size 12 font, double spaced, and may not exceed 2 pages.

All submissions must be received by **April 30, 2024.** Application packets must include the scholarship application, applicant's essay and a printout or transcript indicating GPA. Printouts from Virtual Counselor or other similar private school websites are acceptable.
