## **HISTORY OF THE FUND**

In 2014, a donor from the congregation of the First Unitarian Universalist Congregation of the Palm Beaches (1stUUPB) donated funds to be used to offer scholarships to those who are choosing to enroll in either public or private colleges or trade schools. Those students who have demonstrated involvement in social justice work and can state a plan for future social justice work will receive priority.

## WHO WAS HARRIETTE GLASNER?

A founding member of this congregation, Harriette Glasner, was devoted to justice. After her arrival in Palm Beach County in 1952, she became a trailblazer in advocating for civil rights, women's rights, reproductive justice and human rights.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARDS**

- Applicants must have earned or be in the process of earning a high school diploma or GED in Palm Beach County.

- Applicants must be enrolled in or have applied for admission into a private or public college, university or trade school, or other certification program.

- The number and dollar amount of awards may vary from year to year. The scholarship committee of 1stUUPB will review applications and announce awards by March 31st.

-The HGSJ Scholarship does not renew automatically. However, prior recipients will be contacted in January of the next academic year with an opportunity to re-apply for an award. Scholarship renewal is dependent upon re-application in a timely manner.
