

FIELD RESEARCH RANGER PROGRAM

Palm Beach County Principals,

This program has been established to encourage families and elementary students to get outdoors and experience the wonders of science in Florida. The initiative incorporates benchmark specific enrichment activities promoting Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). This is a collaborative initiative between RISE organizations (Resources in Science Education) and the School District of Palm Beach County. The ultimate goal of this program is to further educate our learning community through highly interactive learning experiences and to foster life-long learning outside the traditional classroom setting.

Sixteen participating RISE organizations collectively offer site-based enrichment activities ranging from geocaching treasure hunts to nature walk challenges for students to enjoy. Participating students will be provided a "Passport" booklet with each organization represented. Students will receive a stamp in their booklet from a RISE organization coordinator signifying the learning task was completed successfully. Once each student has all the RISE pages stamped in the passport booklet (*completed) they will be officially deemed a "Field Research Ranger". The student will receive a certificate of completion and Palm Beach County's official Field Research Ranger patch. This is an annual event and the learning experience is provided without time restrictions. Furthermore, K-5 participating students will receive free admission into all participating organizations.

All site-based learning activities focus on Next Generation Sunshine State standards and integrate a variation of Florida Standards in mathematics, reading, and writing. This effort supports classroom instruction by providing standards—based learning experiences intended to strengthen background knowledge of subject matter.

We invite students and families of Palm Beach County to get involved and experience learning through this unique and highly motivational program. We ask that you encourage your students to get "Field Research Ranger" certified and share in the excitement of this hands-on learning adventure. Please consider distributing the passport booklet at your school site or directing parents to our website to obtain the passport. We thank you for your support.
