

VPK/Parent Fee Enrichment Program 2025-2026 School Year

Are you interested in a high-quality prekindergarten program taught by certified teachers for your 4-year-old child?

If your child turns 4 years old by September 1, 2025, consider enrolling your child in our VPK program that starts on August 11, 2025, to ensure your child learns foundational skills for school and life success. Priority will be given to children who live in our attendance zone and to those who are siblings of students currently enrolled in our International Spanish Academy Dual Language program on a first come first serve basis. Once the priority enrollment period ends, enrollment for all other students will begin until the class is full. If your child turns 4 years old between February 2 and September 1, 2025, you may delay enrolling your child for another year.

What:

If enrolled in the District's VPK program, your child is eligible to participate in our VPK/Parent Fee Enrichment program, a full-day, seamless 6-hour day, from 8 AM to 2 PM. The parent fee for the full day is \$23 per day with a VPK Certificate. Parent fees may also be paid by a School Readiness (subsidy) voucher. The District's VPK program provides free VPK hours plus parent fee enrichment hours creating a full-day program.

Since most parents choose to enroll their child in the full-day program, two seats in each classroom are reserved for children whose parents only want a part-day experience (VPK hours only). Additionally, VPK Wraparound hours after 2 PM up to 4 PM may be offered for a separate fee based on the availability of seats through our Afterschool Program Director, Rico Ramirez at 561-651-0531.

How:

Step 1: Obtain a VPK Certificate online

Step 2: Visit your school in person to apply for a VPK seat

- SDPBC does not use an online application for VPK enrollment.

Step 3: Register by bringing the following documents to our school:

- VPK Certificate
- Child's birth certificate or passport
- Two current proofs of residency
- Health Form (DH 3040)
- Certificate of Immunization (DH 680)
- SDPBC Registration Documents
